(ROSEMARY LANE, DOWNHOLLAND, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2017

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to proceed over that length of Rosemary Lane, Downholland from outside the property known as Rosemary Farm to outside property number 9 Rosemary Lane, Downholland in the Borough of West Lancashire.
2. The prohibition will be operative from 0900 hours on Monday 12 February 2018 until 1700 hours on Wednesday 21 February 2018 or until completion of the works within this period.
3. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Rosemary Lane – A5147 Delf Lane – B5195 Broad Lane – Bye Lane – Rosemary Lane, Halsall – Plex Lane, Halsall – A5147 Southport Road, Downholland – A5147 Wanishar Lane – Rosemary Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow utility works to be carried out.
