(ROSEMARY LANE, DOWNHOLLAND, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2017

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to proceed over that length of Rosemary Lane, Downholland from outside the property known as Rosemary Farm to outside property number 9 Rosemary Lane, Downholland in the Borough of West Lancashire.
- 2. The prohibition will be operative from 0900 hours on Monday 12 February 2018 until 1700 hours on Wednesday 21 February 2018 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 3. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Rosemary Lane – A5147 Delf Lane – B5195 Broad Lane – Bye Lane – Rosemary Lane, Halsall – Plex Lane, Halsall – A5147 Southport Road, Downholland – A5147 Wanishar Lane – Rosemary Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow utility works to be carried out.
