NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council intend to make an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Rosemary Lane, Downholland from a point outside The Ship Inn to a point outside 7 Rosemary Lane.
- 2. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours on Saturday 23rd June 2018 until 1530 hours on Monday 23rd July 2018, or until completion of the works within this period.
- 3. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Rosemary Lane – Bye Lane – B5195 Broad Lane – A5147 Delf Lane – Rosemary Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Scottish Power works to be carried out.
