(STATION ROAD, DOWNHOLLAND, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2018

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to proceed over that length of Station Road, Downholland from its junction with Well Lane to approximately 30 metres east of property number 116 Station Road in the Borough of West Lancashire.
2. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> May 2018 until 1700 hours on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2018 or until completion of the works within this period.
3. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Station Road – A5147 Southport Road – Plex Moss Lane – Heathey Lane  
– Station Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow utility works to be carried out.
