(C104 SCHOOL LANE, DOWNHOLLAND, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council intend to make an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of C104 School Lane, Downholland from X6616 Plumb Court, Downholland for a distance of 35m in a Westerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Saturday 24th October 2020 until 1700 hours on Sunday 1st November 2020 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

C104 School Lane, Downholland – C105 School Lane, Downholland – C105 Black-A-Moor Lane, Downholland – B5195 Black-A-Moor Lane, Downholland – A5147 Delf Lane, Downholland – C104 School Lane, Downholland and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the installation of two new manholes in the carriageway and a new sewer connection to be carried out under a S50 licence by Oakwood Construction Ltd.
